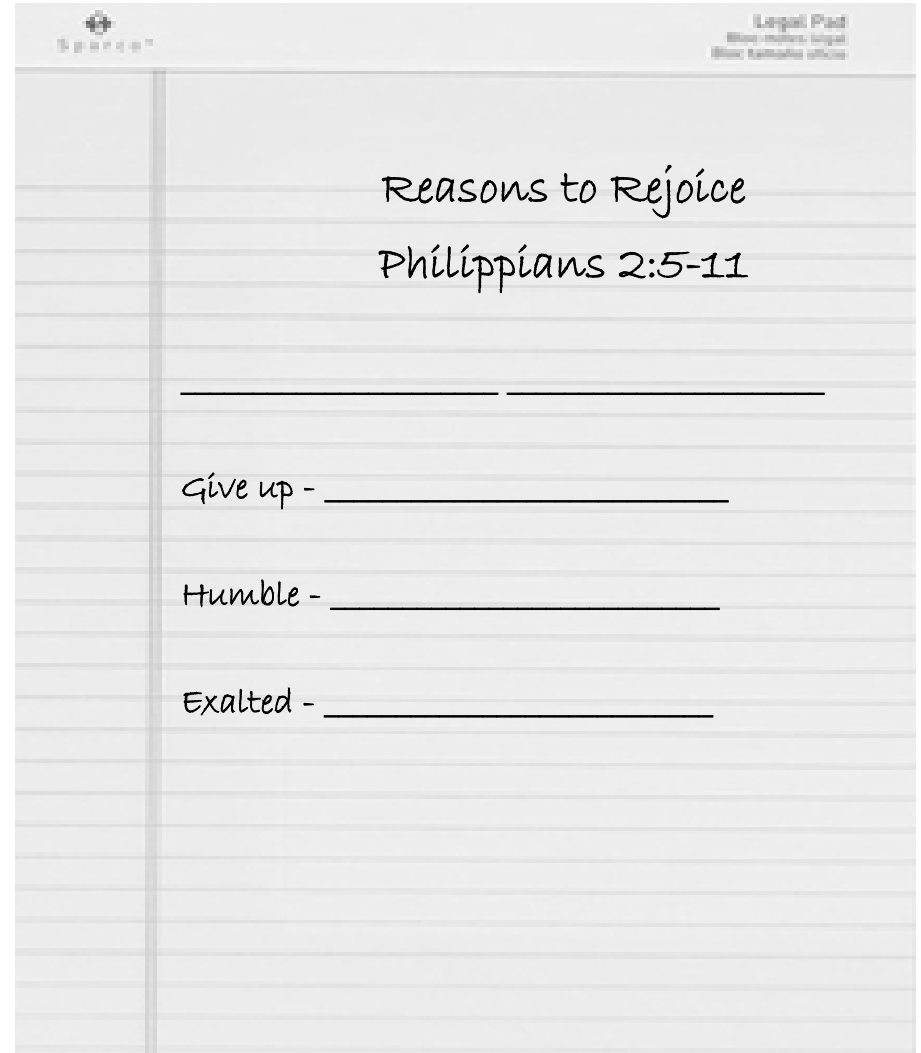
Por Los Niños

In our efforts to support the great work being done by *Por Los Niños* in Honduras, a second collection will be taken today.

About house parents: It has always been the ambition of Family Life Missions/Por Los Niños to create an environment to help the Honduran people make their lives better. When you think about this, you probably think "children" and that's correct. Our mission has been to take the hopeless and destitute children of Honduras and give them the nurturing of a good Christian home. We have realized that we can help in other ways to accomplish these objectives.

The house parents of Por Los Niños are strong Christians providing day-to-day care and oversight for a house full of needy children. Each set of house parents has up to 10 children in addition to any biological children they may have. Most of us can only imagine the difficulty of routine problems they face each and every day. Our house parents are also faced with being the role models for these children. They are encouraged to better themselves in every way possible to set an example we would want the children to follow. We currently have three house parents in school, attending evening or weekend classes to set a standard the children can see and aspire to follow. Of course, there are many ways to improve yourself as a role model; going to school isn't the only way.
